Thank you for being a member of the team providing refreshments on Sunday mornings. This is part of the wider ministry of the church and continues to be appreciated by many people.

Tea, coffee, sugar and squash are provided in the kitchen cupboard. Please contact the Church Office or Pauline Stanford if supplies are running low.

Refreshments are served between the two morning services.

- Two **earlies** to arrive in good time before the 9.30am service starts to put the urn & coffee machine on and set up the table with cups & saucers, etc, so everything is ready immediately the first service finishes. It is best to organise two service points – one for tea and one for coffee, with squash and biscuits on the small table. This avoids a long queue forming and speeds up the serving process.
- **Earlies** to bring milk, please.
- Two **lates** to arrive at 10.40 am to help the **earlies** serve the refreshments.
- **Earlies** and **lates** to clear up and wash up as far as is possible during the half-hour between the two services. **Please don't clear everything away too quickly after the main rush, as arrivals for the 11.15am service may also want refreshments. This is especially important at All Age Worship services.**

**Lates** to finish the clearing up and washing up after the 11.15am service has finished if necessary.

If you have any suggestions to improve the routine please do let me know. If you are unable to do the dates given, please try to arrange a swap or contact the Church Office on 01922 455229.
